A Bill to Establish a Dress Code for Senate Meetings

Whereas,

Since its founding, the Student Government Senate has abided by an unwritten dress code.

Whereas,

The dress code has been understood as “business professional.”

Whereas,

Adherence to a professional dress code ensures that the Senate upholds a professional image and conveys respect toward both constituents and fellow senators.

Whereas,

Article IV of the bylaws governs the rules of debate and decorum.

Be it enacted that,

The Student Government Association Senate, acting in its official capacity as the representative of the undergraduate student body of The Catholic University of America, hereby introduces the following section into the Senate Bylaws:

1. Article IV, Section 8 “Dress Code”, Clause 1: “Members are expected to dress in business attire for all Senate meetings. For men, this means a coat and tie; for women, professional business attire.”

The Student Government Association Senate, acting in its official capacity as the representative of the undergraduate student body of The Catholic University of America, hereby renumbers the following sections:

1. Article IV, Section 8 to Section 9
2. Article IV, Section 9 to Section 10
