In the previous Academic year of The Catholic University of America the cost of tuition, room, and board was raised by 3.8 percent.

Whereas:

The affordability of tuition, college fees, and other miscellaneous college expenses requires the careful financial planning of all students and families desiring to attend and/or are attending the University.

Whereas:

A Tuition Guarantee Program within Private and Non-profit Public Universities, has annually increased and been instituted to protect, to provide, and to ensure a consistent rate for every University student for up to four or five Academic years.

Whereas:

A fixed Tuition rate for the Catholic University of America students, and each of Catholic University's Schools, be beneficial to the students and families for clarity in financial planning purposes and providing peace of mind to future families.
