

Resolution 008: A Resolution to Create a Winter Academic Term

Whereas,

The Catholic University of America does not currently offer a Winter Academic Term.

Whereas,

Out of the eighteen (18) institutions in the Consortium of Universities in the Washington Metropolitan Area, only three (3) offer a Winter Academic Term in Washington, D.C.

Whereas,

For a number of reasons undergraduate students can have difficulty fulfilling graduation requirements on time.

Whereas,

The existence of a Winter Academic Term would allow undergraduate students to complete introductory, intermediate, and remedial courses in a timely fashion.

Whereas,

The existence of a Winter Academic Term would provide an additional revenue neutral benefit to The Catholic University of America.

Whereas,

The existence of a Winter Academic Term would not affect the amount of classes offered in the fall or spring semester.

Be it enacted that,

The Student Government Association Senate, acting in its official capacity as representative of the undergraduate student body of The Catholic University of America, hereby requests that:

1. The Undergraduate Board create a Winter Academic Term to take place between the opening of the University after New Year's and the start of the Spring Semester. T
2. The Winter Academic Term be able to offer courses at both the introductory and intermediate levels.
3. The Winter Academic Term be created in conjunction with the Student Government Association's Academic Affairs Committee.
