A Resolution Mandating Midterm Grades

Whereas,

The Catholic University of America does not currently mandate professors to display the midterm grades of all students on Cardinal Station.

Whereas,

Only faculty teaching freshman are required to display midterm grades on Cardinal Station.

Whereas,

Students should be able to easily know the midterm grade for each class they are enrolled since the grade conveys their performance in the class at the midpoint of the semester.

Whereas,

The requirement of mandating midterm grades for all students would allow them to be aware of their total grade during the midpoint of each class prior to the end of the semester.

Whereas,

If the student does not find the midterm grade satisfactory, the student would know there is a need for improvement and a change in their approach to the class material and assignments.

Be it enacted that,

The Student Government Association Senate, acting in its official capacity as representative of the undergraduate student body of The Catholic University of America, hereby requests that the administration mandate that professors must report individual student grades prior to week eight of a semester. The midterm grade will consist of all cumulative graded assignments prior to the report. That this report will be submitted and observable on Cardinal Station for every class which the student is enrolled in.
