**A Resolution to Redesign the Cardinal Card to Reflect University Branding and
Commitment to Student Well-Being**

Whereas,

The Cardinal Card is the official identification card at The Catholic University of America, which all registered students are provided upon matriculation to the University. Students use this card to receive a variety of services and should be in their possession at all times.

Whereas,

The Department of Public Safety, the Counseling Center, and Student Health Services are three emergency resources available to members of the student body that are often utilized.

Whereas,

The University recently redesigned its official logo.

Whereas,

The back of the Cardinal Card still displays the University's old logo, minimal information, and has unutilized white space.

Be it enacted that,

The Student Government Association Senate, acting in its official capacity as representative of the undergraduate student body of The Catholic University of America, hereby requests that the Office of Transportation and Parking Services redesign the back of the Cardinal Card to (1) incorporate the new University logo, and (2) include the phone numbers for the (a) Department of Public Safety, (b) Counseling Center, and (c) Student Health Services. The newly designed Cardinal Card shall be provided to registered students starting with the incoming Class of 2023.
