Whereas,

Catholic University students live in suite and apartment style housing in Opus Hall, Millennium North Hall and Millennium South Hall.

Whereas,

Theft has occurred in spite of the Department of Public Safety's campaigns to reduce opportunity theft.

Whereas

Institutions of similar size, such as SUNY Oswego, and our neighbors at UMD- College Park, have security camera systems in residence hall common space.

Be it enacted that,

Security camera systems be placed in the hallways of Opus Hall, Millennium North Hall, and Millennium South Hall for the purposes of video review only in the event of a reported crime or threat of, without regular monitoring.

1. If a student reports a crime, the videos may be reviewed.
2. For video review, a Department of Public Safety Officer, Dean of Students, respective Community Director, and respective Resident Assistant must be present.
3. Upon tape reviewal, only the crimes or student code of conduct violations raised by the student may be prosecuted. And amnesty would be given to students caught in the tapes with lesser and unrelated violations.
