Whereas,

The on-campus speed limit at The Catholic University of America is 15 miles per hour.

Whereas,

There are only a few speed limit signs throughout Catholic University's campus.

Whereas,

The Office of Parking and Transportation Services is responsible for installing speed limit signs on campus. The Department of Public Safety is responsible for enforcing the campus speed limit.

Whereas,

Campus drivers often violate the campus speed limit, which creates safety concerns for members of the Catholic University community.

Whereas,

Spreading the awareness of and enforcing the campus speed limit is needed to hold University drivers accountable and to keep the University community safe.

Be it enacted that,

The Student Government Association Senate, acting in its official capacity as the representative of the undergraduate student body of The Catholic University of America, hereby requests that

1. The Office of Parking and Transportation Services install additional speed limit signs.
 - a. The placement of these speed limit signs should emphasize visibility to drivers while not infringing on the natural beauty of the campus.
2. The Office of Parking and Transportation Services notifies parking pass purchasers and campus guests of all driving regulations on campus, including the campus speed limit, in an official manner.
