Whereas,

There is a road on campus that connects Harewood Road NE to John McCormack Road NE.

Whereas,

This road passes by Facilities Ground Center, O'Boyle Hall, Marist Annex, Marist Hall, Aquinas Hall, Eugene L. Kane Student Health & Fitness Center, Walton, McDonald and then divides into two roads, one that goes to the Edward J. Pryzbyla University Center and the other road goes to John McCormack Road NE. Whereas,

The section of the road behind Aquinas Hall to O'Boyle Hall has parking along the sides of it. The road is a two way road and is around a bend, with parallel parking spots intermittently dispersed on both sides.

Whereas,

It is dangerous for pedestrians walking on said road due to traffic, as well as aforementioned parallel parking spots alongside said road.

Be it enacted that,

The Student Government Association Senate, acting in its official capacity as the representative of the undergraduate student body of The Catholic University of America, hereby request that the University adds a sidewalk along the stretch of road currently without a sidewalk that connects Harewood Road NE to John McCormack Road NE.
