There are limited choices for food within the Pryz Food Court and few healthy food options for students.

There are many precautions that have been successfully implemented by the Pryz Food Court and Murphy's Grill in order to safely provide students with food during the coronavirus pandemic.

### Whereas,

The Spring 2021 University plan brings more students to campus. Therefore, more students will purchase meal plans which will create longer lines during peak meal times and over crowdedness within the Pryz Food Court.

The health of students is the highest priority to the University and this includes having various food options and promoting healthier lifestyles.
