Whereas,

There are specific requirements that must be met prior to completing an undergraduate degree at the Catholic University of America that are specific to the school(s) and program(s) of study in which a student is graduating.

Whereas,

The requirements include but are not limited to a specific number of minimum credits or courses completed at the physical university, the minimum number of major related courses, and minimum number of elective courses completed in order to be eligible for completion of one's degree.

Whereas,

A review of one's courses and when they are on track to complete their requirements can be requested by any students and is highly recommended for students who are entering their final year at the university.

Whereas,

This review is completed by the same individuals who ultimately have the power to approve or disapprove the completion of a student's degree from the university.

Whereas,

Most students do not know that the opportunity to have a schedule audit exists, as there is little to no information about it on the website and it is not advertised by those in the Center for Career and Academic Success (CACS) or by academic advisors.

Be it enacted that,

The Student Government Association Senate, acting in its official capacity as the representative of the undergraduate student body of The Catholic University of America, hereby requests that each academic school and program of study set up a process that requires all students to complete a schedule audit before they are allowed to register for their courses for their final year of attending the university and clearly communicate this information to all students.
