A Resolution to Include Parking at the DuFour Center with On-Campus Surface Parking Passes

Whereas,

About one-third of our student population is made up of collegiate student athletes.

Whereas,

Students who reside on campus and choose to purchase a surface parking pass are granted access to park in the OPUS Parking Lot and the Centennial Village Hill.

Whereas,

Parking at those locations is often scarce or a great distance away from athletic practices/events or other events.

Whereas,

Students who reside off campus and choose to purchase a surface parking pass are granted access to park in any lots (including the DuFour Center Parking Lot) except faculty only and residential parking (OPUS Parking Lot and the Centennial Village Hill).

Whereas,

The 2022-2023 academic year will be the first year that the university will fully implement the housing policy that mandates freshman, sophomores, and all juniors to reside in on-campus housing.

Whereas,

Many student-athletes choose to participate in jobs and internships requiring them to go directly from those activities to practices or other sports related events.

Be it enacted that,

The Student Government Association Senate, acting in its official capacity as the representative of the undergraduate student body of The Catholic University of America, hereby requests: that the parking passes be reconsidered for the new academic year of 2022-2023 to allow parking in the DuFour Center for students who have purchased a surface parking pass.
