A Resolution to Establish an Annual “Brookland School Arts Project”

Whereas,

The Catholic University of America (CUA) is located within the Brookland community in Washington, D.C.

Whereas,

The Brookland community is filled with several different elementary and middle schools.

Whereas,

CUA has an established connection with many of these local schools through the DC Reads Program.

Whereas,

It is a duty and mission of CUA to continue to serve and support the Brookland community.

Whereas,

Earth Day is an internationally recognized event that occurs annually on April 22nd.

Be it enacted that,

The Student Government Association Senate, acting in its official capacity as the representative of the undergraduate student body of The Catholic University of America, hereby requests that the University establish an annual “Brookland School Arts Project” that will include the following:

1. The project will take place over a six week period, starting on March 13, 2022 and ending on April 24, 2022.
2. The project will consist of “Earth Day” themed artwork that will be displayed in the following public buildings on-campus:
 - a. Inside and outside of the Edward J. Pryzbyla Center
 - b. Inside of the Raymond Dufour Athletic Center
 - c. Inside of Heritage Hall
3. The project will include artwork from the following Brookland schools:
 - a. St. Anthony Catholic School
 - b. Mary McLeod Bethune Day Academy Public Charter School (PCS)
 - c. Washington Jesuit Academy
 - d. Beacon House
 - e. Higher Achievement at Brookland Middle School
 - f. Hope Community Public Charter School - Tolson Campus
4. An event will be held at the conclusion of the project for the children, parents, and teachers involved with the artwork.
 - a. This event will take place in the immediate week following Earth Day.

- b. This event will take place in the Edward J. Pryzbyla Center.
- 5. The University will sponsor this project and publicize it on all social media platforms.
