Whereas,

These tables can be found in the Food Court, the third floor outside of the Starbucks, the second floor study room, and the first floor outside of the Pryz Market.

Whereas,

A good number of the tables have broken or loosened bases, resulting in wobbling, uneven weight distribution, and leaning, making them inadequate for common use.

Whereas,

A good number of the chairs in the Przybyla Student center, especially in the food court, have broken backs, easily bent out of shape and providing no support.

Be it enacted that,

The Student Government Association Senate, acting in its official capacity as the representative of the undergraduate student body of The Catholic University of America, hereby requests that

1. The circular tables in the Food Court, first floor, second floor, and third floor of the Pryzbyla Student Center are repaired or replaced to ensure that they remain level and steady when in use. 2. The broken chairs at the aforementioned tables are repaired or replaced in a timely manner.
