Whereas,

Faculty and staff of NCSSS have voiced feelings of being overlooked because while NCSSS is its own school within The Catholic University of America, there are no defining features of Shahan to make it known as the NCSSS building.

Whereas,

Diversity Inclusion is extremely important to NCSSS, as their mission is to educate students on issues related to equity, culture, and social justice through their implementation of a NCSSS DEI (Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion) Task Force in 2015.¹

Whereas,

A Diversity Inclusion Mural painted on the entrance to NCSSS would curate a sense of pride amongst NCSSS students and faculty, making known the beautiful nature of the diverse school of social service.

The Student Government Association Senate, acting in its official capacity as the representative of the undergraduate student body of The Catholic University of America, hereby requests that

1. A Diversity Inclusion Mural is placed inside of the entrance to the NCSSS Office of Shahan.
2. The mural is funded by a donor who has agreed to donate up to \$500 towards NCSSS and its endeavors.
3. The mural is created by a Catholic University student who recently created another mural on campus.
